

# Sofology Sofacheck

## Frame Construction & Suspension (Springs & Webbing)

- Full internal check on all framing issues, which includes a tightening of all wingnut-type fixing bolts.
- Re-tighten all external retaining screws, i.e. a tightening of feet bolts.
- Checking modular connector clips are secure and in place.
- Check the slats and fixings on a sofa bed base are in working order and in the correct position.

## Interiors & Cushions

- Where the seating consists of springs, a check will be made for any cracking, splintering or erosion of any metal work.
- Where the seat has webbing, a check will be made for overall elasticity and for fraying or cutting of the webbing.
- Full standard dress of all cushions and an explanation given of a daily care regime to help extend the life of your product – an information leaflet is included.
- Sofa beds - flipping and rotating the mattress, plus explanation of a care regime via a leaflet.

## Seams & Stitching

- Full check of all structural and decorative seams.
- Decorative stitching check.

## Health & Safety Check

- Check there are no sharp elements and parts out of alignment, or protruding issues caused by use during the first 24 months.
- Highlight any other health & safety issues, such as recliner positioning.

## Electrical Components

- Full visual check of all electrical items, which includes the buttons, switches, ratchets, mechanisms and transformers.
- Re-routing of all cables back to where they were originally located by the manufacturer.
- Re-tying of all broken or dislodged cable ties.

## Mechanisms

- Education of how unusual or excessive use could impact joint wear.
- Education on sitting and daily usage and an explanation of the care regime to help extend the product's life cycle.
- Re-tightening all internal bolts, brackets and screws.
- Sofabed lay test.

## Leather & Fabric Coverings

- Care Kit maintenance, including an explanation on how to use a Care Kit to get the best results.
- Check leather surfaces for peeling or cracking.
- Check decorative elements, such as studs or buttons, are still intact and secure.
- Check there is no loss of colour.
- Education on the transfer of natural body oils and the effects of oil transfer, to help extend the life of the product.
